Expressions of interest are sought from appropriately qualified individuals seeking appointment as Chairman of Red Meat Advisory Council Limited (RMAC).

RMAC is the peak national policy council for Australia's \$15 billion red-meat and livestock industry. RMAC has five members: Australian Meat Industry Council, Cattle Council of Australia, Sheepmeat Council of Australia, Australian Lot Feeders' Association and Australian Livestock Exporters' Council. The Goat Industry Council of Australia has observer status.

RMAC's four principal functions are to:

- provide advice to the federal Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry, the Minister's colleagues and department on cross-sectoral and whole-of-industry matters;
- act as custodian of the Meat Industry Strategic Plan that is used as a guide for industry programs;
- ensure responsible management of a parcel of industry investments, known collectively as 'The Fund', in a manner consistent with an established industry/Government agreement; and
- allow a forum for its members to discuss multi-level sectoral policy issues.

The successful applicant, who will commence on 1 July 2010, will have a sound knowledge of financial and corporate-governance responsibilities, an understanding of the industry's current structure and processes and be cognisant of the range of policy issues handled by RMAC and its member bodies.

The successful applicant will also be prepared, when required by the Board, to act in an advocacy role for the industry and be skilled in promoting co-operation between its members when devising whole-of-industry policy and strategies.

A remuneration package will be negotiated as part of the selection process.
